Notice To Exhibitors

1. Telephone, Conditional and Unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms or photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries without fees are not acceptable. Fees must accompany entries.
2. Post dated checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Club will add a collection fee of \$25.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor(s) may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
3. **PLEASE TYPEWRITE or NEATLY PRINT** all entries. Use black or blue ink. Do not use pencil.
4. **CHANGES, ADDITIONS OR CORRECTIONS** to entry forms must be received **IN WRITING** prior to close of entries. Changes are not acceptable by telephone. E-mail or faxed changes are allowed.
5. **ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS** — Owners alone are responsible for the correctness of entries, or for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which the dog is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date and time. Due to cost of processing, no refunds less than \$4.00 will be made.
6. **FIRST ENTRY OF EACH DOG IN CONFORMATION OR OBEDIENCE** includes an AKC Recording Fee of \$.50. In addition, each entry of a dog in single-entry recording classes includes \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee. These fees are required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test and are collected by the show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, these fees are collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). Each Beginner Puppy entry fee includes a \$2.00 AKC recording fee.
7. **ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED** in event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event's Show Committee. If, because of riots, wars, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, strikes, national emergencies, health emergencies, extreme weather conditions (including but not limited to extreme heat, floods, hurricanes, lightning, or earthquakes), or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors, and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fees will be made.
8. **ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRY AND SCHEDULE OF JUDGING TIME** will be sent to the address on the Official AKC Entry Form after the closing date, as soon as practicable. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the Schedule within seven days of the show, please notify the Show Secretary.
9. **DECLINATION OF ENTRIES:** The Club may decline any entry for cause, and may refuse to receive, or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.
10. **PLEASE NOTE:** Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Sec 6)
11. **DOGS MAY ARRIVE** any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
12. **DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** The Club and/or its Show Secretary will not be responsible for, and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class.
13. **NO DOGS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE SHOW AREA** except those regularly entered in the show. There will be **NO SPACE** for unentered dogs at this show. All dogs shall be kept on leash or confined, except when being judged or in the exercising ring.
14. **ALL AWARDS WILL BE MADE** in the judging ring to the person exhibiting the dog and that person shall be considered the owner or the agent. All claims for trophies must be made in the judging ring before the completion of judging, and the Show Secretary should be advised at once of any discrepancy. The show-giving club and its officials disclaim any liability for any awards not claimed on the day of the show.
15. The Club will take every precaution for the safety of dogs exhibited, but it is understood that the Monterey Bay Great Dane Club will not be responsible for loss. The welfare of the exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. Please secure proper crates or means to confine dogs for the welfare of all concerned.
16. No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.
17. As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Veteran Dogs (6 years & under 8 years) Veteran Bitches (6 years & under 8 years)
Veteran Dogs (8 years & over) Veteran Bitches (8 years & over)
Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered and shown in Veteran classes at independent specialty shows. Winners of the above classes are eligible to compete for Best of Breed if undefeated in all classes.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

(No defeated dogs will be allowed to compete in BOB)

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition. Dogs that are Champions of Record, or Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the day of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records. Winners of the Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch Classes may also compete in the Best of Breed Competition, provided that they are undefeated in any Regular Class at this show.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

STUD DOG CLASS - For dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the get. The owner of the stud dog need not be the owner of the get. Neutered dogs are allowed to compete in the Stud Dog Class. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in this class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Stud Dog must appear in the ring with his get and be entered in the Stud Dog Class. The Get must be entered in a regular class at this show.

BROOD BITCH CLASS - Same as Stud Dogs, except replace brood bitch for stud dog, and produce for get. Spayed bitches are allowed to compete in the Brood Bitch class.

SPECIAL AWARDS

- **AWARDS OF MERIT:** After selecting Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch, the judge may present Awards of Merit, at his/her discretion to any exhibit competing in Best of Breed. The number of awards to be offered may be up to two (2) of the dogs entered in Best of Breed.
- **BEST PUPPY IN REGULAR CLASSES:** To be chosen from the winners of the Puppy 6-9, Puppy 9-12, and BBE Puppy classes.
- **BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR:** To be chosen from the winners of the BBE Puppy and BBE Adult classes.
- **BEST VETERAN:** To be chosen from the winners of the four Veterans classes.

Sweepstakes

One Competition to be held with Morning show only.

SWEEPSTAKES RULES

Sweepstakes is open to all Great Danes who are at least 6 months and under 18 months of age on the day of the show. Dogs entered in Sweepstakes must be entered in a Regular Class. Champions of Record are not eligible to compete in Sweepstakes. Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes, morning show only. Indicate "Sweepstakes" and age division on the regular entry form under "Additional Classes." Entry fee is \$20.00 in addition to the regular class fee.

SWEEPSTAKES PRIZE MONEY

After 35% has been deducted by the Club to defray expenses, money received for entries will be distributed as follows: First Place - 100% of the class.

Honors Parade

With Afternoon Show only.

Open to all Great Danes 6 months & older who have earned titles, achieved Veteran status (6 years and older), or been lovingly rescued. Indicate Parade of Champions or Veterans or Title Holders or Rescue under "Additional Classes" on the entry form. Honors Parade entrants need not be entered in another class at this show.

Reminder: Unentered Dogs

AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Ch 11, Sec 11

Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under The American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed within the show precincts, except that dog engaged as a special attraction with AKC approval may also be present (e.g., a puppy ENTERED in the Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition). These dogs shall be subject to all rules relating to health and vaccinations.

The **SHOW PRECINCTS** will be defined as **within 10 feet** from the Great Dane Conformation Ring. It is the responsibility of the Show Committee and the Show Secretary to enforce the AKC rules. If a puppy is within the show precincts and appears to be less than 6 months old, then either that puppy must be entered in the Four-to-Six Mo. Puppy Competition, or the owner must provide proof that the dog is 6 months of age or older, and proof of vaccinations or a letter from your veterinarian describing his/her vaccination protocol. If you cannot provide these, then your puppy must be removed from the show precincts. Failure to comply may result in a Bench Show Committee hearing may be called.



Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition

One Competition held during the lunch break between shows

SPECIAL CLOSING DATE: FRIDAY, JULY 15, 2022 at 10:00 AM

Open to all Great Dane puppies that are (4) months & under (6) six months of age on the day of the show. The class is not divided by sex, and there will be a selection of Best of Breed Beginner Puppy and Best of Opposite Sex to Beginner Puppy.

- ◆ An AKC registration number or litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed or Miscellaneous breed.
- ◆ A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- ◆ Dogs are required to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized.
- ◆ Entry Fee: \$5.00 per puppy. Use the Official AKC Entry Form from the premium list to enter. Indicate "4-6 mo. Puppy" on the entry form under "class".
- ◆ **SPECIAL CLOSING DATE for the Beginner Puppy Competition is July 15, 2022 at 10:00 AM, the morning of the competition.** Note that entries received after the show's closing date of June 29, 2022 will receive an entry confirmation, but may not receive a Judging Schedule, and may not be included in the Specialty Show catalog.
- ◆ All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise. AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition.
- ◆ Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy for the judges.
- ◆ No puppy can be judged if it is bandaged, taped, glued, stitched anywhere including ears or tail. These dogs will be excused from judging, but, at judge's discretion, may return to the ring to be judged after the tape or bandage is removed.
- ◆ Breed standard disqualifications such as color, height, weight or dentition shall not be a point of consideration in the judging process for this Best Beginner Puppy in Breed Special Attraction.
- ◆ Professional Handlers are not allowed to exhibit in this competition. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.
- ◆ Judging will be done in during the lunch break and WILL NOT RUN concurrently with the regular class judging.

NO PUPPIES UNDER THE AGE OF SIX (6) MONTHS, EXCEPT THOSE PARTICIPATING IN THE FOUR-TO-SIX MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION, MAY BE WITH THE SHOW PRECINCTS!
